



### **Best Practices for Practicum Supervisors: Working With Students**






People have a natural need to connect and belong.

Belonging means that you have feel accepted, included, or part of something else.







Not belonging can be linked to feelings of worthlessness, self-doubt, isolation, and sadness.

"When students feel a sense of belonging in the classroom, it can increase their educational success and motivational outcomes in multiple ways, and teachers can help create this feeling of belonging by building connections between classroom and community"
