	Process	
	Role of teacher	Role of student(s)
Before	Acknowledge that social entrepreneurial projects are chosen based on a passion for a community need resulting in a group whose members may not have all the qualities necessary to carry out the project. The first step is taking stock of what qualities individuals have. Use the attached activity sheet for the first time before students have been involved in an entrepreneurial project. If you do not have an <i>Entrepreneurial Qualities Wall</i> in your classroom, create one by using chart paper or bristol board where students can post their qualities and all students can and use it as a reference.	Listen, reflect and contribute to a discussion
1	Provide each student with the Profile Entrepreneurial Qualities activity sheet. Allow students time to examine and to ask clarifying questions. Provide instructions on how to complete the activity sheet.	Each student will critically examine a list of entrepreneurial qualities as described in the Entrepreneurial program. They will have the opportunity to ask any clarifying questions necessary for understanding and complete the activity sheet as instructed.
2	Ask each student to choose the two entrepreneurial qualities that best describe him/her and describe what these qualities looks like in action. They will each write their information on cue cards.	Each student will choose two entrepreneurial qualities that best describe him/her and will provide an example of what these qualities looks like in action. They will each record their information on cue cards.
	Each student will also find two resources that provide a definition of his/her particular entrepreneurial qualities and add this to the cue cards. Ensure that the cue cards are added to the <i>Entrepreneurial Qualities Wall</i> .	For homework each student will find two resources that provide a definition of his/her particular entrepreneurial qualities and add this information to the cue cards, which will be added to the <i>Entrepreneurial Qualities Wall</i> .
3	Ask students to select 2-4 qualities that they want to continue to develop. Provide students with the <i>From Goals to Actions graphic organizer</i> to set action goals and select strategies on how they will go about developing each quality targeted.	Using the <i>Entrepreneurial Qualities</i> activity sheet, each student will select 2-4 qualities that they want to continue to develop. They will use the <i>From</i> <i>Goals to Actions graphic organizer</i> to set action goals and strategies on how they will go about developing each quality targeted.
Follow-up	Ask students to complete the Profile Entrepreneurial Qualities activity sheet at different times during the project process (before, during, after).	Students may choose to review their entrepreneurial qualities at different times. They may find that this is a useful process midway through the year.
